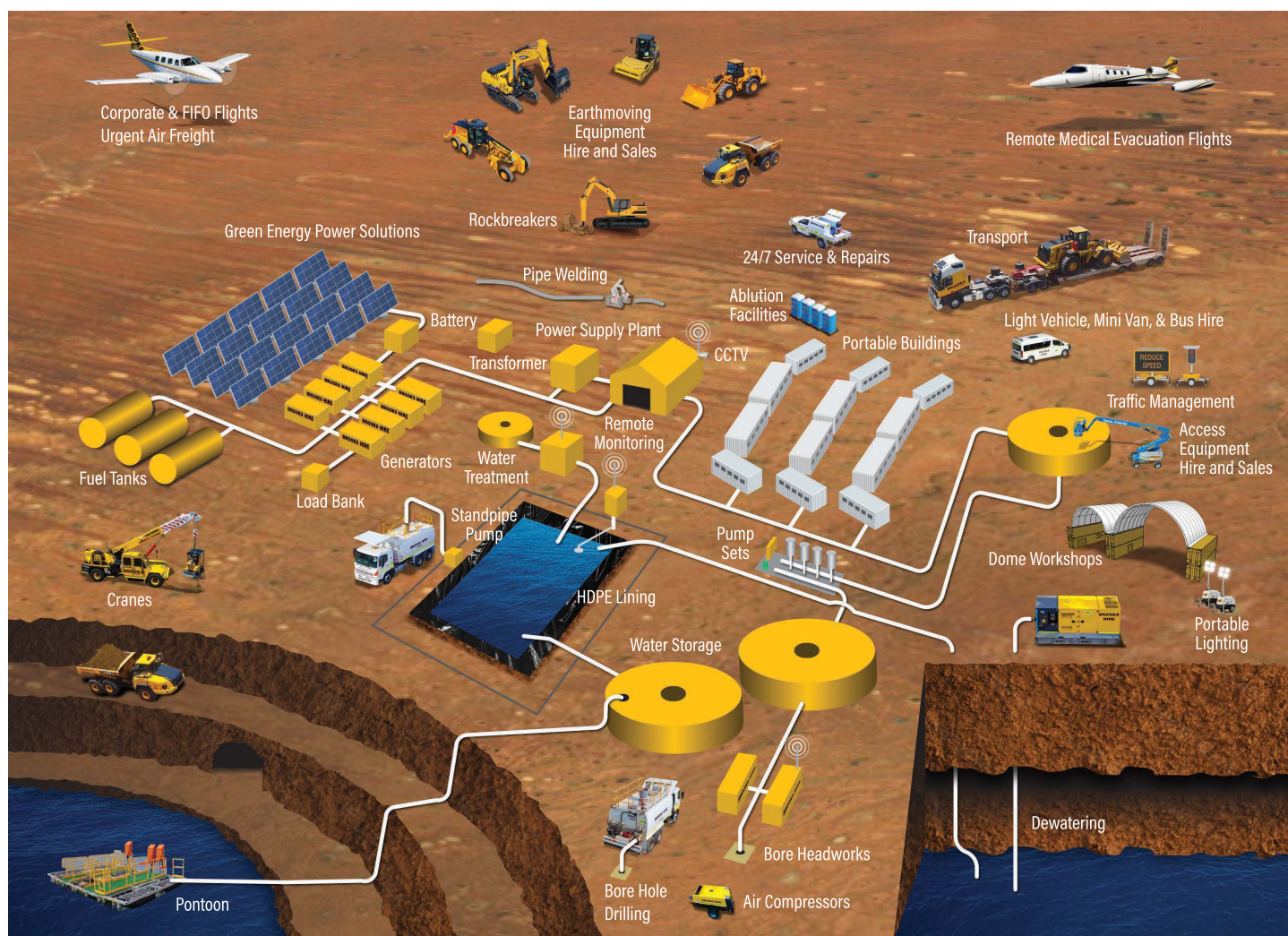

HOW DID IT ALL BEGIN...

The very first pieces of equipment that Doug Brooks purchased for Brooks Hire back in 1979, was two used un-serviceable compressors. After getting the compressors going, he started hiring them out, then graduated to pumps, and so the business grew.

In 2021, managing Director Stuart Brooks reflected on where the business began and purchased a whole new fleet of quality compressors, pumps, generators, and light towers. "Just hiring the equipment out didn't fit with our company ethos of 'service first', remarked Stuart. "We knew that with the right team, we could help our customers set up and maintain their whole work site."

In August 2021 Brooks sourced professional staff with extensive experience in construction and mine site management to kick start the Site Services department.

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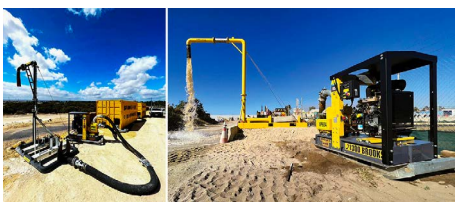

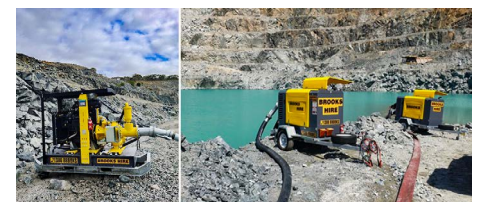

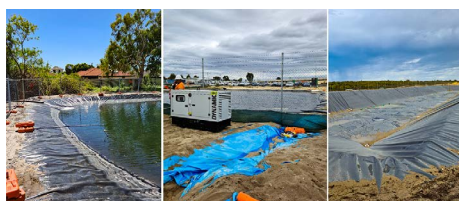

BROOKS FORMED A JOINT VENTURE WITH OLIVE BRANCH RESOURCES

In 2023, Brooks embarked on a joint venture (JV) with 100% Aboriginal owned mining service contractor, Olive Branch Resources (OBR). Registered as BROOKS OBR MAIA, the purpose of this joint venture is to give back to the Aboriginal community, and focus on the three success pathways for the traditional owners on country, to create a legacy for the next generation.

Three pathways to success: AWARENESS - EMPLOYMENT - BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

■ AWARENESS

At Brooks, we recognise the importance of Australia's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander heritage and pay respect and understanding of their culture, history, and lifestyle. Brooks is committed to incorporating Aboriginal culture, people, and businesses into all aspects of our company.

In 2022, Brooks commissioned the services of talented Indigenous artist, Sister Danielle Champion to design an artwork for our new Volvo prime mover. The piece is called "The Seven Sisters", and has a special Indigenous story behind it.

In 2023, Danielle Champion and the Champion family conducted cultural awareness training with the Brooks team. To greater understand Aboriginal seasons, Danielle and the Brooks team combined their talents to produce 'Seasons'. The artwork reflects the six Aboriginal seasons, Birak (December/January), Bunuru (February/March), Djeran (April/May), Makaru (June/July), Djilba (August/September), and Kambarang (October/November).

Binar Futures

In April 2023, Brooks recognised an opportunity to offer ongoing support to the Aboriginal community by creating a charity machine in our fleet. We used Danielle Champion's artwork to decorate a telehandler, and asked Danielle to choose an Aboriginal charity that was close to her heart. Danielle chose Binar Futures. Binar Futures is an Aboriginal youth support program that brings young people into contact with their culture. A percentage of all profits earned by the telehandler goes directly to Binar Futures.



Malakai Champion

Malakai Champion is an up and coming AFL star. At the age of just 17 years old, Malakai was selected as a 'Future Stars' player. As one of the top 46 players in Australia, Malakai was given the opportunity to represent Western Australia at the 2023 AFL Futures match ahead of the 2023 Grand Final. Players were nominated by state talent programs, national selectors, and AFL clubs.

Brooks is a proud sponsor of Malakai, helping him achieve his AFL career goals.



Western Heat Indigenous Netball Team

Western Heat Indigenous State Netball Team is a community lead initiative that was started by Katrina and Winston Abraham in 2018. Western Heat is an all Aboriginal, travelling netball squad that participates in Indigenous interstate netball carnivals. In January 2023, Brooks proudly sponsored the supply of all team bibs for the Western Heat girls.



National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Golf Championships

The National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Championships is a 72-hole stroke event open to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people.
