📂 Brain Teasers

Answer: Farmer takes Goat across (leaving Wolf and Cabbage behind). Farmer returns alone. Farmer takes Wolf across. Farmer returns with Goat.

\* We now have the Farmer, the Cabbage and the Goat on one side and the Wolf on the other side.

Farmer takes Cabbage across. Farmer returns alone. Farmer takes Goat across. DONE!



Answer: Three. Two ducks are in front of the last duck; the first duck has two ducks behind; one duck is between the other two.

Answer: Eleven. Because Lisa lost three games to Susan, she had lost \$3 (\$1 per game). So, she had to win back that \$3 with three more games, then win another five games to win \$5.
