So, he called his boss and said, "Hey boss, my password is out of date." His boss replied, "Yes, that's right. The password is different. Listen carefully. I am sure, you can figure out the new one. The new one has the same amount of letters as your old password, but only four of the letters are the same." With that, the man could correctly log into his station. What are both the old and new passwords?

Answer: "OUT OF DATE" and "DIFFERENT" Letters: D, F, E & T
